Youth Exchange for Young People 18-29 years old

40 young people aged 18 to 29 supported by 10 youth workers and group leaders from 8 different countries; Italy, Greece, UK, Croatia, Cyprus, Hungary, Spain and Portugal.

It will take place in Turin from 12th January 2022 (arrival day) to 20th January 2022 (departure day).

Group Leaders will play a crucial role in creating inclusive and creative learning environments that foster the integration and development of young people and their ideas. One way to achieve this is through the principles and methods of non-formal education, because thanks to this type of approach, young people are encouraged to reach their potential and to be active members in their local communities. Considering the international dimension, young people receive essential tools to face global challenges through local actions. The program will use the peer to peer approach and self-directed learning, to which will be added the preparation of a campaign with the creation of graphic/video/audio/slogan /letters to/for local politicians with concrete proposals for action, to bring home the learning and share it with the world.

The program is designed to generate discussions and opportunities to share stories and experiences that highlight the skills and methods to overcome the daily environmental challenges faced by young people in the European and global context.

Mobility will see the implementation of different non-formal education methods and tools. The most important aspect of the methodology, however, is the self-directed dimension, the participants engage in self-discovery through learning by doing and reflection moments. In this way they will have the opportunity to better understand the methods and tools used and therefore to prepare themselves for their application once they return home.

Welcome to Turin (Torino in Italian)

Turin may not have the name recognition of Rome, Venice and Florence, but this cultural city in the north west of Italy has been the first Italian capital. The cradle of Renaissance, industrial capital, city of art and culture, innovation pole. It offers to visitors a perfect combination of architectural and monumental jewels, museums (over 40), art galleries, entertainment, good food, Baroque, Neo-classic and Liberty palaces, spacious piazzas lined with 19th-century cafes, the Chapel of the Holy Shroud, delicious chocolate and ice-cream.



Through the programme we will have the opportunity to explore some outdoor activities in the city and even in the countryside.

Turin is situated between the Alps which crown it on the west side and the hills on the east side. During the youth exchange, we expect proper winter weather conditions with temperatures around $-1/+6^{\circ}\text{C}$ and high possibility of rain or snow.

- All travel proofs, such as boarding passes, invoices and bus tickets should be kept by the leaders and brought to the organizers in good condition.



Food

- Breakfast will be provided in a buffet, from 7.30 until 09.15 (mainly: milk, tea, coffee, bread, butter, jam, cereals ...)
- In our meals we are going to test mainly Italian traditional food; there will be a lot of pasta and pizza but also local and regional delights.
- According to the daily programme we will organize lunch and dinner in some restaurants or with packet box.
- For any dietary needs, please inform the organizers.

Travel reimbursement

The reimbursement will be done in a group basis to the Bank Account of the Sending Organization and only after participants have fulfilled the evaluation. A special reimbursement form will be designed and sent to partner organisations prior to the arrival of participants.

Just make sure that you keep all of your tickets, as we will need copies to prove that you actually traveled to Italy.

Arrival and departure dates may be a maximum 1 day prior/after the start /end of the event, but extra stay will not going to be covered by the project.

COVID 19 NOTE

Please be informed about all the Covid-19 travel restrictions.

Participants need to have a valid GreenPass (EUDigital COVID Certificate) that contains one of the following:

- Proof of full vaccination (Pfizer BioNtech, Moderna, AstraZeneca, Johnson&Johnson).
- Proof of recovery from COVID-19. Validity: 180 days from the first positive swab.
- Negative result to a COVID-19 test. PCR - molecular (Validity: 72 hours. Cost 70/80€) and rapid antigen tests (Validity: 48 hours. Cost 15/20€). Note that costs related to covid tests are not covered by the organizers.

What to bring

- Winter warm clothes and waterproof warm jacket.
- Towels, toiletries, flip flops/slippers
- Workshop/activity/presentation about what is positive and negative in terms of environment and climate change in your local contexts
- Some goodies to introduce us to your culture.
- Power is provided by Euro Plug, be ready with adaptors.
- Be provided with the estimated cash that you will need, but ATMs are available as well.
- In the venue OPEN 011 there is a bar with snacks and soft drinks and a snack machine on every floor.



Rules

- Rules are going to be shared and defined by the group on the first day.
- It's not allowed to go out from the hostel without informing the group leader.
- Drugs are not allowed according to Italian law.
- In case of emergency there will be always a car with us and there is a well-equipped hospital close to the venue (emergency number 112).
- Smoking is allowed in the smoking area, only in free time.
- personal use of the mobile phone during the activities is not allowed.

Insurance

- All participants should be informed (and act accordingly) for the possibility to be provided with a European Health Insurance Card, available from each respective country's social welfare system.
- All participants are covered by civil responsibility under the activities of MADIBA SCS from ASSIMOCO insurance company.
- If you need a negative test to come back to your country, we recommend that you purchase additional travel insurance with Covid quarantine options.

Carignano Palace & Risorgimento Museum

The Palazzo Carignano in Turin (1679) is Guarini's masterpiece of palace design. With its billowing facade, its magnificent curved double stair, and its astonishing double dome in the main salon, it well deserves to be acclaimed the finest urban palace of the second half of the 17th century in Italy. Birthplace (1820) of King Victor Emmanuel II and once the meeting place of the Sardinian chamber of deputies and of the first Italian parliament, now houses the National Museum of the Italian Risorgimento.

Mole Antonelliana & Cinema museum (www.museocinema.it)

Symbol of the city of Turin, the Mole Antonelliana's construction begun in 1863 and was designed by Alessandro Antonelli to be a synagogue. In 1878 it was sold to the city who wanted to make a monument dedicated to the king of Italy Vittorio Emanuele II.

This unique building, 167 meters high, is currently home of the National Museum of Cinema, the only one of its kind in Italy. Museum collections offer to visitors a journey through the history of cinema through a path on five levels: the Archaeology of Cinema, the Film Machine, the collection of posters, the video installations and the great Temple Hall surrounded by 13 chapels that tell about some great themes of the seventh art (Fantastic and Horror, Animated Film, Fiction, Love and Death, Western)

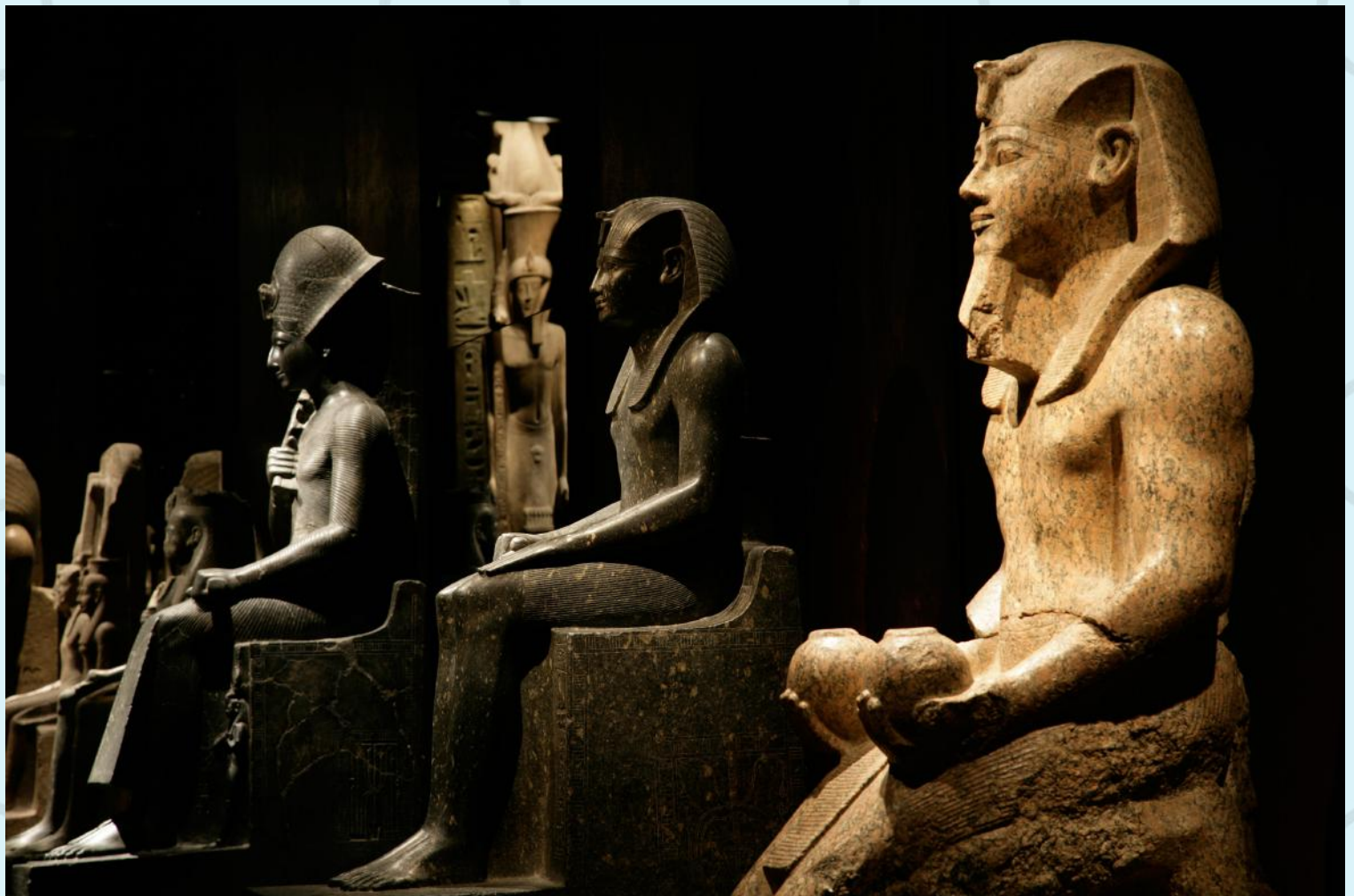
Egyptian museum (www.museoegizio.it)

This museum, dedicated exclusively to the art and culture of ancient Egypt, is in Turin since two centuries. The foundation of the Museum is dated back in 1826, year in which Carlo Felice, King of Sardinia, bought the collection of a French consul in Egypt: Bernardino Drovetti.

The collection, successively enriched by purchases and excavations, nowadays is made by more than 30,000 pieces, including statues of pharaohs, sarcophagi, funerary steles, jewelry, everyday objects (there are “only” 6,500 exposed). This make the Museum of Egyptian Antiquities in Turin one of the richest Egyptian museums in the world.

Car Museum (www.museoauto.it)

The National Automobile Museum, inaugurated in 1960, is one of a limited number of museums dedicated entirely to this vehicle in the world, and it is the only one in Italy. The museum has a collection of almost 200 cars among eighty automobile brands representing eight countries (Italy, France, Great Britain, Germany, Netherlands, Spain, United States of America, Poland). The museum's collection includes the first Italian cars, a Bernardi from 1896 and a Fiat from 1899 but also Formula 1. The museum is situated in a building dating from 1960, and it has three floors. The exhibition area is 19,000 square metres (200,000 sq ft).
